BRADD v3.2.9.1 Patch Available

Since the release of BRADD v3.2.9.0, three operational issues have been reported and resolved as described on the Summary of Revisions included with this e-Notification.

These issues have been addressed in BRADD v3.2.9.1 which can be downloaded for free as a patch from the BRADD website by all users with a current license for BRADD v3.2.9.0.

Downloading and Installing BRADD Version 3.2.9.1 Patch for Existing Licensees:

1. Close any existing instances of the BRADD program.
2. To download the patch, go to the Downloads page on the BRADD website at <https://bradd.engrprograms.com/home/> and select to download the BRADD version 3.2.9.1 Update (BRADD v3.2.9.1 Update Install.exe).
 - a. It is possible that you will see a download warning from your browser for this EXE (e.g. "... isn't commonly downloaded. Make sure you trust ..."). This EXE has been digitally signed and is trustworthy.
 - b. After the download, you may need check the "Unblock" checkbox in the file's properties in order to run the installation.
 - c. Please contact RA-PDBRADDMANAGER@pa.gov if you are unable to successfully run the installer.
3. Enter your License Number, License Key and Company Name for BRADD v3.2.9.0 and your name and e-mail address.
4. Save the file on the computer with BRADD v3.2.9.0 installed.
5. Run the update executable and BRADD v3.2.9.0 will be uninstalled.
6. Run the update executable again and BRADD v3.2.9.1 will be installed.

Installing BRADD Version 3.2.9.1 Patch for PennDOT:

PennDOT's CADD workstations will be updated by CADD Support.
