Operating System Clarification for BRADD

The purpose of this e-Notification is to clarify the supported operating systems for BRADD.

Problem Statement:

The following statement in the BRADD "Getting Started.pdf" file on the CD and in the BRADD User Manual has caused confusion.

From BRADD "Getting Started.pdf"

"The program runs as a 32-bit application and is supported on Windows 2000 and Windows XP operating systems. At this time BRADD is not supported on the Windows XP Professional x64 (64 bit) operating System."

Clarification:

Microsoft sells the following editions of the Windows XP operating system as documented at the web site <http://www.microsoft.com/windowsxp/>.

- Windows XP Home Edition
- Windows XP Professional Edition
- Windows XP Media Center Edition
- Windows XP Tablet PC Edition
- Windows XP Professional x64 Edition

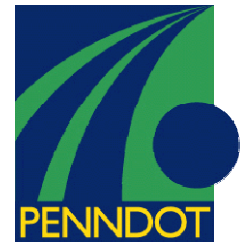
The **only** version of Windows XP that is supported by BRADD is the "Windows XP Professional Edition". BRADD is also supported on the Windows 2000 operating system.

Note: The version of Windows XP installed on a PC can be determined by selecting the System icon in the Control Panel.
